



### Letter to Families RE: Summer and Next School Year

Dear Brooklyn Ascend High School Families:

Thank you for your continued partnership to bring this unusual academic year to a successful close for your children. The rapid and unexpected shift from classroom-based learning to remote learning required all of us to quickly adapt to new technology, new schedules, and new ways to communicate. I'm so proud of our entire school community – students, families, and staff – who have diligently worked together to make this transition a success. At Brooklyn Ascend High School, our average attendance during remote learning has been 89.72%!

We know that this summer will also be unique for your family as many traditional activities for kids have been cancelled or shifted to a remote platform. Although Ascend will not offer summer school in grades K-8 this summer, BAHS will still be hosting remote summer school for select students. Regardless if your student attends summer school or not, Ascend has created grade specific summer homework packets for every grade to help keep our students engaged and excited about learning this summer. These homework packets offer a rich array of learning activities and are similar to the high-quality learning activities that we have provided in the past. Families will receive these resources in early July. Scholars are expected to complete summer homework before the first day of school in the fall.

We've created [this](#) helpful guide, which contains information related to summer meal distribution and the Pandemic Electronic Benefit Transfer (P-EBT) Food Benefit, for which all Ascend students are eligible.

We are also actively planning for safely welcoming your children back to learning in the fall. While we do not yet know exactly what the 20-21 academic year will look like, we're planning for a number of scenarios and will be prepared to provide a safe and enriching environment to support your child's learning, whether that's in a physical classroom, virtual classroom, or some combination of both. We are preparing a survey for parents that will inform our planning. You should expect to receive that survey from us very soon.

As our plans develop and we learn more from public health and government officials about new safety protocols and regulations, we'll keep you posted on what to expect this fall.
